### TEACHERS:

### GUARDS:

Patron Safety is #1.

Hose every night and disinfect when scheduled to do so. Changes are in the works to make this easier.

### NO CELL PHONES BY STAFF IN THE POOL AREA EVER (or any devise)

- NOT even tucked in a bag or pocket
- it can be checked on your break
- if it's of importance ask desk staff to cover so you can use it
- if it's for music, use the sound system
- guards have first choice of music, if we find staff can't agree then I will look into a music device with a speaker for the desk staff or desk staff can tap into MASA's Wi-Fi to play music on their device.
- the guard must use the sound system to avoid distraction of changing music sources or songs.
